**Project Viable Babies Postcard Campaign Launches This Weekend**

This weekend our parish will be signing three postcards to our 3 Representatives (Senator Joseph A. Lagana, Assemblywoman Lisa Swain, Assemblyman, P. Christopher Tully) to ask them to support the "Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act" (A-1686/S-537) which would protect babies in the womb at 20 weeks (5 months) and beyond. Babies at this stage can feel excruciating pain. Seventeen states have already passed this bill. We need to pass it in New Jersey! The post cards are inserted in today's bulletin. Please fill them out and mail them this week.

**Why should I register in the parish?** - All members of the parish should be formally registered as members of the parish. However, you **MUST** be formally registered if you wish to arrange a Baptism, a Confirmation, or a Wedding in the parish Church. You **MUST** also be formally registered if you wish to register in the Parish School or the Religious Education (CCD) Program. You **MUST** be a registered member of the parish for at least three months before you can obtain a Sponsor Certificate or schedule a Baptism or a Wedding.

**POSSIBLE EMAIL SCAM** (From the Archdiocese)

Please be aware of an email scam that currently is being perpetrated against parishioners in the Archdiocese of Newark. Several parishioners have already been contacted.

The scam involves parishioners receiving an email supposedly from a parish pastor or priest asking for a favor. The email instructs the recipient to reply to the email, and once the parishioner responds, a follow-up email asks them to purchase gift cards or other similar items of monetary value.

Please advise all in your parish or school that if such an email comes in, the recipient should not reply to the email or provide any information. Instead, parishioners should alert their pastor, parish administrator or school administrator and law enforcement.
