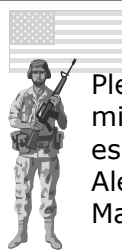

LESSON FOR THIS WEEK

When a family member passes away, it is a difficult moment for you and your child. Our third graders are learning about eternal life with God and how He wants us to enter heaven. They are learning about how the Catholic funeral Mass gives us hope. My grandchildren always remember that we are near their home when we pass by the "stone park". The stone park is what they call the cemetery. We think of parks as pleasant places but might think of cemeteries as sad places. The stones at the cemetery should fill us with the wonderful memories of our loved ones. We add flowers, or light perpetual candles there or maybe place rocks atop the stone. It is there that we pray for their souls and maybe even hold conversations with our loved ones. For our children and grandchildren, this is a good way of teaching the corporeal and spiritual works of mercy (bury the dead and pray for the living and the dead). No one can take away the sadness, but Catholics trust that death is the beginning of eternal life with God.

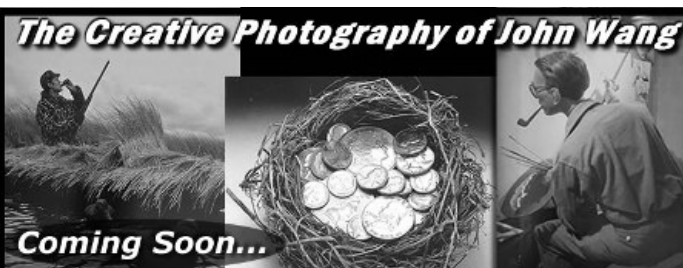

Why should I register in the parish? - All members of the parish should be formally registered as members of the parish. However, you **MUST** be formally registered if you wish to arrange a Baptism, a Confirmation, or a Wedding in the parish Church. You **MUST** also be formally registered if you wish to register in the Parish School or the Religious Education (CCD) Program. You **MUST** be a registered member of the parish for at least three months before you can obtain a Sponsor Certificate or schedule a Baptism or a Wedding.
