UPDATE YOUR INFORMATION - Be sure to update your information for our parish census. This includes any changes in names, addresses, phone numbers and email addresses. Soon we will begin sending out reminders of important parish events using email. Some test emails have been blocked because our address wasn't recognized. The one we use for these emails is olqp400@yahoo.com. Thank you!

Why should I register in the parish? - All members of the parish should be formally registered as members of the parish. However, you **MUST** be formally registered if you wish to arrange a Baptism, a Confirmation, or a Wedding in the parish Church. You **MUST** also be formally registered if you wish to register in the Parish School or the Religious Education (CCD) Program. You **MUST** be a registered member of the parish for at least three months before you can obtain a Sponsor Certificate or schedule a Baptism or a Wedding.
