Maintenance & Repairs Update

It has been a very busy year for us with all of the things that have needed to be done. Here is a list:

- 70 bulbs replaced in the church chandeliers (\$265 cost only of bulbs; labor was volunteer)
- Window leak in Sanctuary fixed (still waiting for wall repair to be done)
- Repairs made in boiler room of school - old pipes needed replacing (\$3,450)
- New ice machine needed for auditorium kitchen (\$2,700)
- All traffic lines repainted (\$3,550)
- Parish center roof parapet still in need of work - possible repointing of all bricks (Roofers tried to stop leaking at a cost of \$3,455 which helped somewhat but not completely)
- Parish center oil tank no longer functioning - temporary tank (\$4,948)
- Bathroom in rectory needed a new shower stall (to stop leaking) and other pipe repairs (\$3,801)
- Walls in rectory repaired after roof and A/C leaks were fixed (\$6,000)
- Fences in back of auditorium to be replaced
- New lights in auditorium to be installed (\$4,500)
- Major work needed to be done in school because of a burst steam pipe. (Our part of shared cost was \$20,000)

These are items that have been (and will continue to be) covered by the very generous contributions that you make to our Maintenance and Repairs collections. When buildings age things begin to break down and if we did not stay on top of the repairs these buildings would begin to deteriorate rapidly.

You **MUST** be a registered member of the parish for at least three months before you can obtain a Sponsor Certificate or schedule a Baptism or a Wedding.
