LESSON OF THE WEEK

Praying the Rosary - Before Christianity, Hindus strung beads and used them to help count their prayers. Buddhists, Taoists and Muslims have also used prayer beads to assist them in their private devotions. Hebrews used to tie 150 knots on a string to represent the 150 Psalms of the Bible. According to pious Catholic tradition, in the 13th century, Mary the Mother of God, appeared to St. Dominic de Guzman, gave him a rosary, and asked that instead of praying the Psalms on the beads or knots, the faithful pray the *Hail Mary, Our Father and the Glory Be*. Fifteen decades made up the original Dominican Rosary, but it was later shortened. Today, most Catholics use the five-decade Rosary. Take time today and every day to pray the Rosary for Peace in this world of ours. We certainly need it! THERE ARE PAMPHLETS IN THE GATHERING SPACE OF THE CHURCH TO HELP YOU PRAY THE ROSARY.

Why should I register in the parish? - All members of the parish should be formally registered as members of the parish. However, you **MUST** be formally registered if you wish to arrange a Baptism, a Confirmation, or a Wedding in the parish Church. You **MUST** also be formally registered if you wish to register in the Parish School or the Religious Education (CCD) Program. You **MUST** be a registered member of the parish for at least three months before you can obtain a Sponsor Certificate or schedule a Baptism or a Wedding.
