STEWARDSHIP - *The Call to Stewardship:*

Becoming a disciple of Jesus Christ leads naturally to the practice of stewardship. These linked realities; discipleship and stewardship, then make up the fabric of a Christian life in which each day is lived in an intimate, personal relationship with the Lord. This Christ-centered way of living has its beginning in Baptism, the Sacrament of faith. As Vatican II remarked, all Christians are "bound to show forth, by the example of their lives and by the witness of their speech," that new life of faith which begins in Baptism and is strengthened by the power of the Holy Spirit in Confirmation. Faith joins individuals and the community of Jesus' followers in intimacy with their Lord and leads them to live as his disciples. Union with Jesus Christ gives rise to a sense of solidarity and common cause between the disciples and the Lord and also among the disciples themselves.

LESSON OF THE WEEK

Dorcas, also known as Tabitha, was a devout woman from Joppa, who lived in the early first century AD. She was recognized for her generosity, kindness, compassion and charitable works. We learn of Dorcas, who practiced real Christian charity by giving her *time, talent, and treasure* to the poor, in Acts 9. A dressmaker and seamstress by trade, Dorcas used her talents and resources to help unfortunate and needy widows by making and donating clothing for them. There are many women and men in today's society who can be considered a "Dorcas". They are generous, kind, compassionate, and charitable. They too give freely of their *time, talent and treasure*. Why should I register in the parish? - All members of the parish should be formally registered as members of the parish. However, you MUST be formally registered if you wish to arrange a Baptism, a Confirmation, or a Wedding in the parish Church. You MUST also be formally registered if you wish to register in the Parish School or the Religious Education (CCD) Program. You MUST be a registered member of the parish for at least three months before you can obtain a Sponsor Certificate or schedule a Baptism or a Wedding.
