#### **LESSON OF THE WEEK**

There is an old form of Ignatian prayer known as the Examen, which is a kind of practice of reflection on one's past experiences, which even can be used on a daily basis. The following is an "Examen for Children" developed by Tim and Sue Muldoon. 1. Quiet the children before bedtime. 2. Ask them what made them happy over the past day. 3. Ask them what made them sad over the past day. 4. Ask them what they look forward to tomorrow. 5. Remind them to thank God for what made them happy, ask for God's help when they are sad, and pray for God's presence in the coming day.
