STEWARDSHIP - *What Do I Own and What Owns Me?* (Continued from last week) The call to discipleship demands a radical response. As portrayed in the Gospel accounts, the Lord's invitation to discipleship is all encompassing. "Go, sell what you have, give it to the poor, and come follow me". The disciples do not fully understand the radical steps they are taking, but they are drawn by the powerful desire to walk with Jesus. They possess an intuitive understanding that his way, which will certainly require sacrifice and a whole new way thinking, leads ultimately to freedom and an abundance of life. Although they are weak, sinful people who do not always live up to the demands placed on them, there is no question that Jesus' disciples have a commitment to a manner of living that is, for them, radically new. REGISTRATIONS FOR NEW YEAR

Registration for the new 2019 – 2020 Religious Education year has begun. Forms are available at the Parish Center and on the parish website. Anyone new to the parish/program should contact the office at the above number/email to receive specific information regarding the program.

TEACHER AIDES NEEDED

High School students who would like to serve as teacher aides in grades 1 and 2 for the fall term should contact the Religious Education Office. You will need to interview and have your parent's permission to serve as a teacher aide.

LESSON OF THE WEEK

The concept of "Covenant" is stressed so much in our religious education classes that we even have our Confirmation candidates sign a covenant when they begin their preparation for the Sacrament. Our ancestors in faith used the term *covenant* to describe God's relationship with them. In the Bible a covenant is a solemn agreement between God and his people, frequently confirmed by a sacrifice to God or a solemn ritual. We read in the Old Testament that God made a covenant with Noah and all living beings after the flood. God made a covenant with Abraham and his descendants. God also made a covenant with Moses on Mount Sinai. Jews today honor this covenant, keeping God's laws and following rituals established centuries ago. In Jesus Christ God has established his new and everlasting covenant. Jesus' Death on the cross is the sacrifice of the *new covenant*---his life and Death restore humanity's relationship with God.
