**GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR OLQP CHURCH**

Our Church will be **open daily from 8 am – 1 pm** observing the policies mandated by the state and local authorities regarding the maximum number of people allowed to be inside the Church at a given time.

- Cardinal Tobin continues to dispense the faithful from the obligation to attend Mass on Sunday is still in effect (see Welcome Back Video article below).
- In accord with national, state and local health directives, those who show symptoms of COVID-19 or who have been exposed to an infected person are not permitted to enter the church for 14 days.
- Masks must be worn by all individuals while in the church.
- Those coming to church are strongly advised to bring with them hand sanitizer for their personal use. They are also greatly encouraged to bring disinfecting wipes to sanitize before and after the specific area they use. This is to ensure and assure the safety and protection of each one.
- Holy water fonts remain empty until further notice.
- Individuals and families must maintain social distancing (six feet) between each person while in the church. Please stay only at the designated and marked area for use. Our Elevator is off limit until further notice.
- Notification and signs regarding the requirement of masks and social distancing are to be posted prominently. Please follow them accordingly.
- Pews, door handles and knobs, restrooms and high traffic areas of the church should be wiped down and sanitized at regular intervals with the removal of trash and other items from the pews. Our Maintenance Crew would regularly do the cleaning of the Church.

**GUIDELINES FOR OLQP CHURCH - PHASE II & III**

**Phase II** - Church will reopen for daily Mass starting **Monday, June 15th.**

**Phase III** - Sunday Mass will resume the weekend of **June 20-21.** Due to the social distancing guidelines, we will be able to safely have 70 parishioners in the Church. Should we have an overflow we may accommodate an additional 50 in the auditorium. The parishioners in the auditorium will be able to view the Mass from the screen. An EM will go to the auditorium to distribute communion.

You MUST also be formally registered if you wish to register in the Parish School or the Religious Education (CCD) Program. You MUST be a registered member of the parish for at least three months before you can obtain a Sponsor Certificate or schedule a Baptism or a Wedding.

**ARCHDIOCESE OF NEWARK ANNOUNCES  
PHASE TWO DIRECTIVES ALLOWING PUBLIC WEEKDAY MASSES  
WITH RESTRICTIONS STARTING JUNE 15**

Cardinal Joseph W. Tobin, Archbishop of Newark, announced this week that Phase Two of the Directives for Re-Opening Churches has been approved as part of the ongoing, three-phase reopening process for parishes throughout the Archdiocese.

Beginning on **Monday, June 15, 2020**, Archdiocesan parishes, which already have been reopened for private prayer, will now be reopened for the celebration of public weekday Masses, as well as Funerals, Baptisms, and Weddings.

**As part of Phase Two, the following protocols will be observed:**

It is the responsibility and decision of each pastor to determine the process and timing for safe reopening weekday public Mass for their local parish. Parishioners are encouraged to contact their local parishes or visit their local parish website for more information.

Based on state public official guidelines, the maximum number of participants for public Masses, Funerals, Baptisms, and Weddings is now set at 25% of the church's capacity or 50 participants in total, whichever is less.

All directives from Phase One remain in force including social distancing, wearing of facemasks, and sanitizing.

Due to social distancing protocols, services should take place in church, not small chapels.

**Phase Three of the Directives for Re-Opening Churches** is expected to commence on Sunday, June 21, 2020, and is contingent upon any further developments or guidance from health and state public officials.

Phase Three continues the dispensation from the Sunday obligation to attend Mass and extends the celebration of public Mass to Sundays with the observance of all directives and protocols on social distancing, wearing of facemasks and sanitizing. This includes no more than 50% of the total seating capacity of the church permitted for a liturgy.
