Dear Friend in Christ,
 Madonna Cemetery has an addition to our existing Mausoleum, the first community mausoleum built in the Archdiocese of Newark, has served the needs of our local community for over forty years. The construction of an addition was necessary if we hoped to continue in this mission.
 The new expansion is called the "All Saints" section and there are several liturgical features of saints that represent the ethnic diversity of our community. There are also private and semi-private areas in the mausoleum addition and there are options for both single and double interment.
 Because we believe that pre-planning is an important family responsibility, we are offering cemetery counseling and information about the mausoleum. If you wish to have more information, please fill out the enclosed form in our brochure that will be at the rear of the Church. You may also contact Madonna Cemetery by dialing: 1-866-392-1951. Of course there is no obligation.

Donation Email Scams - This is a reminder that there has been an increase in the number of fraudulent emails across the country. Recently we have received notification of email and text scams that will use the name of a pastor to solicit funds in the form of gift cards or cash donations. The email asks for financial help for a worthy cause and concludes with the pastor's name. If you feel that you have been the victim of this type of scam please contact our local police department.

Why should I register in the parish? - All members of the parish should be formally registered as members of the parish. However, you **MUST** be formally registered if you wish to arrange a Baptism, a Confirmation, or a Wedding in the parish Church. You **MUST** also be formally registered if you wish to register in the Parish School or the Religious Education (CCD) Program. You **MUST** be a registered member of the parish for at least three months before you can obtain a Sponsor Certificate or schedule a Baptism or a Wedding.
