### **Deacon Christian Scalo - Autobiography**

Dear Parishioners of OLQP,

My name is Deacon Christian Scalo and I was born and raised in Northern NJ along with my two older sisters.

My journey toward the Priesthood really began around age 6 (I am 28 now), although I didn't know it at the time. I can remember running around the house with the entire towel closet emptied trying to find a suitable altar cloth and robe to "play priest" - one of the first seeds God placed in my very young heart. As I began to mature into high school, I sensed the richness of my call around the age of 16, although at that point, I was still too afraid to accept it. I continued on to college, studying Biology with a pre-medical focus at Immaculata University in Pennsylvania and graduating Summa Cum Laude with that degree and a minor in Psychology. As I was nearing graduation, I felt a strong pull in my heart that it was time to fully embrace the Lord's call to the Priesthood.

I announced my decision to enter the seminary to my family on Holy Saturday of the Easter Vigil. They were overjoyed. It seemed like even though I had delayed in coming to this realization, they had known all along that the Priesthood was meant for me. It is the best decision I have made in my entire life and I have never been happier.

I am now a newly Ordained Deacon and preparing for Ordination to the Priesthood in May 2021, God-willing. I am delighted to have been assigned to your parish family here at Our Lady Queen of Peace and am very excited to walk with you all as we live our lives of faith together.
