From Fr. Tony:

Dear OLQP Parishioners,

My most heartfelt and warmest greetings to each and every one of you!

Since this is my first weekend here, please allow me to take this occasion to introduce a little of myself to you.

I am Father Antonio "Tony" Ricarte, originally from Cebu, Philippines. I was raised in a large Catholic family of nine children. Early on in life, my parents tried their best to impart the gift of faith to me; and because of that gift, I felt the call to the priesthood. I was ordained on June 16, 1998.

Four years after my ordination, I was given the opportunity to leave my country to take further theological studies in Missiology at the Gregorian Pontifical University in Rome. During the period of my studies in Rome, I came to the US for the first time in July 2003 as a "summer priest" at St. Joseph Church, Oradell, NJ. That marked the beginning of my journey in the Archdiocese of Newark.

Before coming here to Our Lady Queen of Peace Church, I have been assigned as Parochial Vicar at St. Joseph Church, Oradell (2009-2011), Sacred Heart Church, Haworth (2011-2013), Our Lady of Mt. Virgin Church, Garfield (2013-2015), and Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Church, Roseland (2015-2019). I was also the Chaplain of Bergen Catholic High School, Oradell (2011-2015).

As I begin my ministry here, I hope to continue the many wonderful things that Fr. Larry Fama has done for our parish as our beloved pastor for 12 years. I am very grateful to him for all his assistance and guidance during the time of my transition to OLQP.

Please pray for me as I pray for you that we together can make our parish truly a "welcoming, worshipping, and witnessing" family of God!

Why should I register in the parish? - All members of the parish should be formally registered as members of the parish. However, you **MUST** be formally registered if you wish to arrange a Baptism, a Confirmation, or a Wedding in the parish Church. You **MUST** also be formally registered if you wish to register in the Parish School or the Religious Education (CCD) Program. You **MUST** be a registered member of the parish for at least three months before you can obtain a Sponsor Certificate or schedule a Baptism or a Wedding.

OUR LADY QUEEN OF PEACE WELCOMES YOU TO OUR PARISH COMMUNITY

How do I schedule a Baptism? Baptisms are scheduled once a month during the year (except during Lent). **Arrangements must be made in advance** by calling the Parish Center and submitting the required paperwork (Completed Information form/Copy of the birth certificate/sponsor certificates). Parents must be registered members of the Parish (on the parish mailing list). Parents and Godparents must attend a class (Baptismal Catechesis) and actively participate at the 12 Noon Mass on the day of instruction.

Sacrament of Marriage - Please make **arrangements** at least **one year in advance**.

Sponsor Certificates - If you are requesting a sponsor certificate for Baptism or Confirmation, you must be registered, practicing and meet all Church requirements for a minimum of 3 months before any certificate will be issued.

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick - Anyone sick or housebound, or who is going to the hospital for tests or surgery, please call the Parish Center.

R.C.I.A. - (The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) - is a journey of faith bringing men and women into full communion with the Catholic Church. If you know someone or maybe yourself, who needs Baptism, First Holy Communion and Confirmation and desires to know our personal Lord and Savior in His Catholic Church, this is for you.
