July 12, 2020

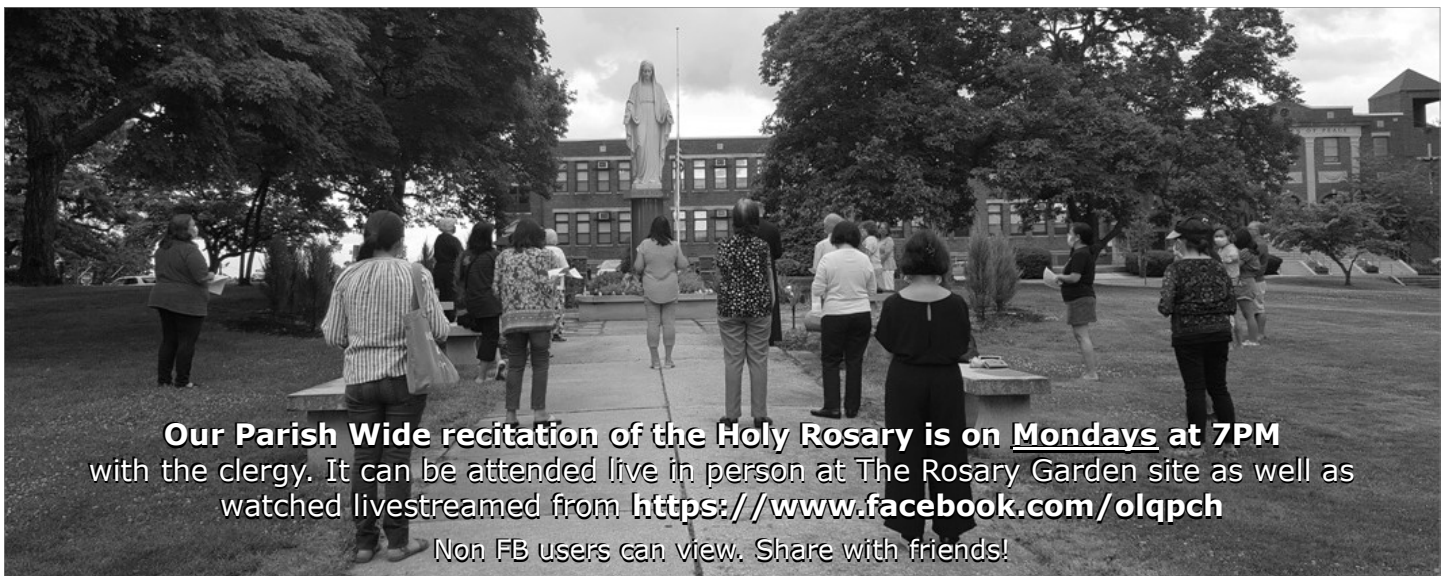
To My Parish Family at OLQP,
