### STEWARDSHIP - *An Engineer, A Psychologist, and A Theologian were hunting in the wilds of Northern Canada:* (Continued from last week)

Let's examine the simplicity of the trapper before we try to get flowery about applying his reality to our own lives. We've all got enough "smarts" to stand back and apply the trapper's conclusion to our **Christian** stewardship: It's just that I had plenty of wire but not much stove pipe!" Sometimes we get so caught up over "stewardship" meaning just money or financial resources that we lose sight of the reality that **God** has given to some of us more time or talent than **God** has given treasure. Whatever the case, **God's** will for our life is that we devote it to **God** as good managers.

**From Fr. Tony:**

Dear Brothers and Sisters of OLQP,

On behalf of Fr. Josef Kiragu, who visited our parish last weekend for the Mission Appeal, I would like to thank you all for the welcome and support you have shown him. We were able to collect in total Two Thousand Eighty Three Dollars (\$2,083.00) for the Diocese of Nyahuru, Kenya. As Fr. Josef has mentioned in his homily last week, our financial help would be used mainly for the promotion of vocation and the upkeep of the seminary in their diocese. I always consider the Mission Appeal as an expression of our being "one family" of God though we are of different cultures, backgrounds, and languages.

We are all children of Our Father in Heaven! That's what our Gospel this Sunday reminds us -the story behind the Lord's Prayer. When the disciples asked Jesus to teach them how to pray, Our Lord said to them, "When you pray, say: Our Father..." The Lord's Prayer begins with the recognition of God as Our Father. And if He is Our Father, then we, each of us, are His Children. We are, therefore, brothers and sisters to one another!

The three of us, Fr. Rafal, Fr. Jonathan, and I, are blessed that we get to live this reality daily in the rectory and in the parish. As you already see, Fr. Rafal is from Europe, Fr. Jonathan is from Africa, and I am from Asia. We are of different cultural backgrounds; and yet, from the moment I arrived here at OLQP, I find "true, caring, and loving brothers" in them. That is what the Lord's Prayer does for me. That is what the "Our Father" gives me - brothers in Fr. Rafal and Fr. Jonathan, brothers and sisters in each and every one of you here in our parish! Isn't that amazing?

Our love and faith in the Father that His Son Jesus Christ revealed to us makes us one family, brothers and sisters, in the Spirit. May prayer is that each of us in OLQP may grow ever closer as one family; may we truly become a living expression of sons and daughters of Our Father and brothers and sisters to one another!
