From Father Tony:

Dear OLQP Brothers and Sisters,

As many of you know, we are celebrating "Catechetical Sunday" this weekend. Each year, the Catholic Church in the United States designates the Third Sunday in September as "Catechetical Sunday"— a day on which we as a parish celebrate and pray for the Church's mission to teach the Gospel to all people. This year's theme is "I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you."

In a particular way on Catechetical Sunday, we celebrate our catechists. All those who teach the Catholic faith and share the Church's teachings are catechists. Lest we forget, parents and guardians are also called to be catechists; they are the first and primary teachers of the faith for their children.

It is my hope that we come together this Sunday to acknowledge the dedication of those who serve as catechists in our parish family. At our 10 am Mass, we have the opportunity participate in the commissioning of our catechists for their ministry and to thank them for what they do for our children.

Allow me to give a short update of our Parish Catechetical Program for this year with Justine Garcia as our Pastoral Associate for Religious Education.

Due to the unprecedented situation we are in, all our catechetical classes are to be done remotely or on-line starting October 4. We currently have 107 children enrolled in our Catechetical Program and anticipating to have a total of approximately 120. I am sincerely grateful to our 15 catechists for Grades K-7 and 2 catechists overseeing our Confirmation Program who have worked as a team to ensure they are properly prepared to bring the teachings of Christ to the homes of our families. This year we have 22 children preparing for the Sacrament of Reconciliation and First Communion and 26 youth preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Let us keep our children, youth, and volunteer catechists in our prayers!

Anyone requesting a Prayer Shawl for a sick person is asked to call the Parish Center.

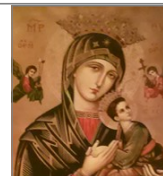
