*Dear OLQP Brothers and Sisters,*

This weekend, I wish to share with you an excerpt of a recently released reflection of Cardinal Joseph Tobin, our beloved Archbishop, on what his vision is for the Archdiocese of Newark. Cardinal Tobin writes:

*My vision for the Archdiocese of Newark is the vision of a missionary disciple.*

*We tend to think of missionaries as other people (not us) who have a special calling and unique gifts. We have come to think of missionaries as clergy, consecrated religious or lay people who travel to distant lands and endure many hardships in order to preach the Gospel to those who do not know Jesus Christ. Pope Francis tells us that this image is not wrong, but it's incomplete. We are all called to be missionary disciples of Jesus Christ who bring his good news to others—in our homes and workplaces, in our parishes and neighborhoods, and in our personal contributions of time, talent and treasure to the Church's worldwide mission. "Before all else," the Holy Father says, "the Gospel invites us to respond to the God of love who saves us, to see God in others and to go forth from ourselves to seek the good of others" (The Joy of the Gospel, #39).*

My hope and prayer is that we will share the vision of Cardinal Tobin for the Archdiocese and make it our own here in our parish.
