Dear OLQP Brothers and Sisters,

We cordially welcome with great joy the Most Reverend Manuel A. Cruz, D.D., Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Newark, to our parish this weekend! It is truly a blessing for us to have Bishop Manny Cruz celebrate the 5:00 pm Saturday Mass and confer the Sacrament of Confirmation to our 36 young candidates.

I believe it is good for us to be reminded of what the Church teaches about the Sacrament of Confirmation. The Catechism of the Catholic Church #1285 states that, "*Baptism, the Eucharist, and the Sacrament of Confirmation together constitute the 'sacraments of Christian initiation,' whose unity must be safeguarded. It must be explained to the faithful that the reception of the sacrament of Confirmation is necessary for the completion of baptismal grace. For 'by the sacrament of Confirmation, [the baptized] are more perfectly bound to the Church and are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. Hence they are, as true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith by word and deed.'*"

In other words, our young candidates receive at their Confirmation both a beautiful gift and an important responsibility. They receive the gift of the special strength of the Holy Spirit that binds them ever closer to the Church; at the same time, they now take upon themselves the responsibility to spread, defend, and give witness to our faith both in word and deed.

Together as a parish, let us pray for each of our Confirmation Candidates that they may give great importance to the gift and responsibility of being confirmed.

Why should I register in the parish? - All members of the parish should be formally registered as members of the parish. However, you MUST be formally registered if you wish to arrange a Baptism, a Confirmation, or a Wedding in the parish Church. You MUST also be formally registered if you wish to register in the Parish School or the Religious Education (CCD) Program. You MUST be a registered member of the parish for at least three months before you can obtain a Sponsor Certificate or schedule a Baptism or a Wedding.
